SECTION A: PLAN OF ACTION CHALKED OUT BY THE IQAC IN THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR TOWARDS QUALITY ENHANCEMENT.

According to the NAAC status awarded to Maharani Laxmi Bai Govt. College of Excellence, an IQAC committee was formed in 2004-05 academic session which promptly performed all its duties. Last year it set up the plan of action for the next academic year of 2010-11.
